

Registered 1999 The Payson/Powell Property Circa 1840



William Payson built this home in 1840 shortly after the construction of the Weymouth Bridge. This New England Colonial home is situated on a gentle slope overlooking the main road leading from Weymouth to Yarmouth. The gables are trimmed with a distinctive bargeboard and a fan window is situated above the main doorway. The Payson family is one of the first families to settle on the south side of the Sissiboo River in the Weymouth Bridge area. Alice (Payson) Powell is the fourth generation to reside in this home.
