New Business Role of Land Use Planning & Cannabis Legislation – Current Situation	The Committee was advised that the age restriction will most likely be 19 years of age and possibly dispensed at liquor stores. The Municipality does not enforce regulations but regulates land use by-laws. A development regulation category for cannabis production or procession may have to be decided - agricultural or industrial. If cannabis is dispensed through NSLC then issues of
